## **CHRISTIAN STANDARDS OF LIVING FOR LEADERSHIP**

It shall be the policy of Victory Family Outreach Ministries (VFOM) to appoint to leadership those members capable of meeting our high stands of character, education and leadership qualities. In addition, those in leadership shall be congenial with other leaders and members, capable of leadership growth and must have made a commitment to Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and live consistent with the Church's Statement of Faith, doctrinal tenets and teachings.

It is imperative that all leaders conduct themselves in a manner that reflects favorable upon this church and the Pastors at all times. Leaders are expected to maintain a consistent demeanor of friendliness, teachable attitude, and a love and concern for others. Critical or negative attitudes, gossip and conduct not consistent with Christian Biblical standards cannot be tolerated and are grounds for discipline up to and including a revoking of clerical credentials. Leaders are expected to be courteous and helpful to the public, to partners of the Ministry, and those doing business with the ministry.

Should a leader's conduct, whether on or off the premises, be criminal, dishonest, immoral in nature including adulterous, homosexual or fornication behavior, unbiblical or detrimental to the best interest of the Ministry, may subject that leader to disciplinary action. The Elders Board is the highest ecclesiastical tribunal of VFOM that is responsible for disciplinary rules in the congregation, and shall be arbiters of whether a leader's conduct is a violation of ministry polices.
